VII: Fee Clarifications:

ITEM 2 MOBILE HOME PARK SITEA; WHEN item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee, the number of unit sites, and a final inspection. WHEN setting a mobile home in a park, or a MODULAR home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, a water service or water distribution pip, and a final inspection.

Item #25: DOMESTIC WATER TREATMENT AND FILTERING EQUIPMENT: a License is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed, and the installation complies with the applicable code. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #25 (see item 3) for \$5.00 each, and the appropriate water distribution pipe size fee (see #14 - #19 below).

Item #26. MEDICAL GAS SYSTEMS shall include the application fee, one Special/Safety Inspection-Medical Gas System #26 (see item #21), and the estimated number of additional inspections in #22.

Item #27 and 28. TOWNSHIP WATER OR SEWER LINE INSPECTION PERMIT APP: **WHEN OBTAINING PERMIT FOR A REPAIR OR INSTALLATION OF A WATER OR SEWER LINE, OR CONNECTING TO THE TOWNSHIP LINES, PLEASE FILL OUT THE WATER / SEWER PERMIT APPLICATION form.** If hooking up to the Township water or sewer lines for the first time, other fees may be required. Please call the Township if you need more information to hook to water or sewer.

IX. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

Please Make Checks Payable To: Benton Charter Township

GENERAL: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with Benton Charter Township. All installations shall be in conformance with the 2021 Michigan Plumbing Code or 2021 Michigan Residential Code (as applicable). **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** The name of the inspector and the telephone number are provided on this permit application form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible (arrange at least 24 hours in advance). The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 180 days after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.
